

ENCA Minutes from the Wednesday September 6, 2006 meeting:

In attendance were: Marci Seamples, Ken Drum, Pat Sova, Karen Homiak, Jim Lackey, Jim Pusateri, Elaine Schimide, Norm Reinertsen, Jeff Macasevich, Donna Fiala, Bob Murray and Ted Beisler.

-many owners from the Greystone Mobile Home Park attended the meeting. Their concern is that the old owner of the property has entered into a new agreement with a new owner and they would have to move. The new owner wants to turn the park into a total RV Park. The new owner is Randall Henderson Jr. Elaine Schmidt offered her help to get in touch with the media. President Murray offered his help.

-Minutes of the July meeting were approved as read.

-Bob Murray gave the Treasurer's report that was unanimously approved.

-Beisler motioned to limit speakers time limit to 15 minutes. All were in favor except Jeff Macasevich.

-Bob Murray is working on a "white paper" on Affordable Housing to be presented at a future meeting. A draft was passed for the Board Members to read.

-In the last discussion regarding the easement behind homes in Queens Park, it appears that the County wants two more feet of the homeowners' land.

-The new newsletter looks great and is less expensive.

-It was felt that pricing at the Sun & Fun Lagoon was expensive and should be reviewed by the County. It was thought that an Annual Pass should be offered. Some Community members are unhappy with the pricing.

-President Murray has a rendering of the new South County Regional Library. It looks very good.

-An East Naples PUD map was distributed.

-Marla Ramsey, Collier County Parks & Recreation, is furthering her feelings on Manatee Park and is not listening to the public and their concerns. Pat Sova distributed a report on the August 17 meeting regarding the Park. Pat also read a letter from Ms. Smallwood, President of Riverwood Park HOA. Riverwood Park HOA adjoins Manatee Park. Some may be seeking a "no confidence" vote on Ms. Ramsey. Ms. Ramsey's intention is to remove the Flying Club from the park.

New Business:

-Should ENCA endorse candidates after the debates? There was discussion but no decision was made.

-The Swamp Buggy Parade will be Wednesday October 27 and will be a night parade.

-The luncheon program was briefly discussed.
