

Minutes from the Wednesday September 5, 2007 ENCA Board Meeting:

President Cannon called the meeting to order at 5:40 p.m. Attending were: Jim Pusateri, Marci Seamples, Ken Drum, Bob Murray, Karen Homiak, Neil Curley, John Hooley, Pat Sova, Ted Beisler and Commissioner Donna Fiala.

-Ken Drum held a meeting with David Rivera. He will partner with Jim Pusateri, Ron Cummings, Karen Vosmik and Tom Rohde focusing on the new Constitutional Amendments. David Rivera will meet with the Committee because he sponsored the bill.

-Ken Drum has 5 people interested in Adopt a Precinct. We need 9 people. If we have 9 people for all 3 elections ENCA will net \$3,000.

-John Hooley, Bob Murray and Marci Seamples continue to work on Scholarships. Most of their work will be conducted in March 2008.

-Code Enforcement-no report

-Karen Homiak reported that \$79 million has been cut from the State Transportation Funds and that monies to widen Davis Boulevard are not available.

-Ken Drum expressed his concern that the DOT continues to cut out left turns from neighborhoods and is making residents make a right turn out of the neighborhood and then in a ¼ mile or so the resident must make a u turn.

-Donna Fiala stated that Target may be backing out of the US 41 and considering moving to 951 and Davis Boulevard.

-Landscaping on US 41 has begun.

-The traffic light at the Hitching Post has been approved and will be completed in about 2 months.

-Wing South may be applying for a zoning change.

-Bob Murray has written a letter to Garrett Richter regarding condominium insurance but has not received a response.

-The School Board has approved hiring 2 new employees and they will replace 3 employees. There was considerable discussion about the School Board.

The Golf Tournament will be held on Friday October 19 at 1:00 p.m. The tournament will be at Naples Lakes Country Club. We need sponsors and players for the event. We also need publicity in the Naples Daily News and the Citizen.

-The new School Superintendent will be asked to speak at the September 20 luncheon. There will be a presentation from the Super Kids Club at our next meeting.
